

Yesterday, October 9, 2011, at the cemetery of the Boer concentration camp of Balmoral, some Boers gathered to mark the anniversary of the birth of [Paul Kruger](#) (president of the Zuid Afrikaanse Republiek, ZAR - literally: "South African Republic", Boer Republic in the region of the Transvaal), born October 10, 1825. The initiative, organized by Boere-Republikeine of [Piet "Skiet" Rudolph](#), also wanted to remind MT Steyn, president of the Orange Free State (Oranje-Vrystaat) from 1896 to 1902, born October 2, 1857, and to commemorate the 24,000 Boer children (50% of the Boer child population of that time) and the 3,000 Boer women, died in the British concentration camps during the Second Boer War of Liberation (1899 - 1902).
